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10. PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

10.1 Reference documents. The applicable issue of documents cited herein, including their approval dates and dates of any applicable amendments, notices, and revisions, shall be as specified in the contract.

10.2 Style and format. The style and format of the Training Facilities Report shall be in accordance with Appendix C of MIL-STD-1379.

10.3 Content. The Training Facilities Report shall contain the following:

- a. Front Matter
- b. Introduction
- c. Requirements
- d. Alternatives
- e. Rehabilitation or Military Construction Requirements:
- f. Budgetary Requirements

Block 10, Preparation Instructions (Continued)

10.3.1 Front matter. Content of the front matter shall be in accordance with Appendix C of MIL-STD-1379.

10.3.2 Introduction. This section shall provide an overview of the existing facilities and identify the reason for the analysis. It shall also identify the objectives and limitations of the report.

10.3.3 Requirements. This section shall identify facilities required to support the training program.

10.3.4 Alternatives. This section shall identify and provide justification for alternatives for the modifications of existing contractor or Government facilities, or the requirement for new construction to support the training program.

10.3.5 Rehabilitation or military construction requirements. This section shall identify any construction or rehabilitation requirements and shall include Standard Form (SF) 1411 for contractor proposed facilities. For Government facilities, this section shall contain a description, cost estimate, and location of the construction or rehabilitation requirements.

10.3.6 Budgetary requirements. This section shall contain the following:

- a. MILCON requirements
- b. Trade-off analysis and budgetary analysis for selection
- c. Initial budgetary estimate and detailed justification for Service rehabilitation or MILCON requirements
- d. Project development brochure for Service rehabilitation or MILCON requirements.
